ONGOING ADS-B IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS IN MALDIVES

SUMMARY

This paper presents information on the ongoing ADS-B implementation process in Maldives to enhance surveillance coverage to improve safety and efficiency of air navigation.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Maldives Airports Company Limited (MACL) has completed installation and commissioning of 4 nos. ADS-B ground stations supplied by Comsoft of Germany in November 2012.
- 1.2 Two stations are installed at Ibrahim Nasir International Airport, 1 station at the Northern extremity of Maldives (Kulhudhuffushi Island) and 1 station at Southern extremity (Fuah Mulah Island).
- 1.3 Integration of ADS-B data to the ATM System has been concluded and controllers are now able to observe ADS-B track on CWPs for monitoring purposes.
